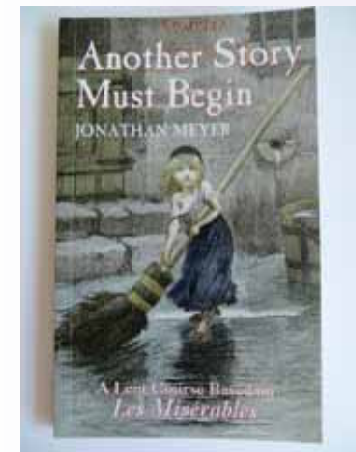

Join us for *Another Story Must Begin: A Les Misérables-themed weekend Lenten Retreat*, by Jonathan Meyer.

Brother Daniel Leckman, SJ will lead this undirected retreat which will use the famous movie/musical “Les Misérables” to help us explore the grace of God alongside our fallen state, the opportunities we are given to experience redemption, and be courageous enough to start ‘another story’ in our lives.

During the weekend, we will explore how 5 different characters of this story (The

Bishop, Jean Valjean, Javert, Fantine and Cosette) can help us reflect both on our faith journey during this holy season and on themes of suffering, forgiveness, renewal (& obviously revolution!) and love.

The weekend will be divided into 5 sessions (not including the screening of the film on Friday night), with an opportunity for group discussions in between them, and liturgy both Saturday and Sunday for those interested.

Dan Leckman, SJ is not a musician, but has a deep love for music in general and is always eager to sing harmonies during sing-a-longs. In his Jesuit life, he loves to tell people that he’s an Urban mystic, eager to encounter God in pop culture and in the City.
