Purpose: Aid in trail maintenance and improvements of IJC hiking and ski trails.

Main Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Trail mowing, brushing and clearing of existing and new trails, routine trail checks
- boardwalk repairs and construction
- tree planting, outhouse maintenance

Qualifications/Skills/Requirements

- Landscaping, grounds care, basic carpentry
- Member of a trail club, trail building experience an asset
- Experience using loppers, hand pruning saws, push mowers

Time Commitment (hours per day/week/month):

Options Include:

- Once a month for routine trail checks, 2-3 hours to walk trails.
- May - September trail mowing and brushing approximately 4 hours a week.
- Occasional hours to complete work if needed after trail checks.
