## **Getting to the Ignatius Jesuit Centre:**

You will be coming to Loyola House, located at the end of the driveway – do not stop at the first large building called Orchard Park Office Centre; follow the blue signs 'Loyola House' to the retreat house and enter up the long sidewalk through the wooden main door.

Arriving by bus or train to downtown Guelph, call Canadian Cab: 519-824-3110 or Red Top Taxi: 519-821-1700 to take you to the **main door of Loyola House** (approx. \$20). **Accommodations:** You will be assigned your own single private room. Should you require a room on the first floor for mobility limitations please let the Registrar know at the time of application. Each room has its own counter and chair, sink & mirror, drawers and lounge chair. The rooms are air conditioned during the summer months.

**Meals** are buffet style at 8am, 12:30pm and 6pm daily unless otherwise posted. The Kitchen will accommodate food needs such as celiac disease, lactose intolerance and vegetarian or vegan diets. Food preferences or dislikes are not accommodated; our food is some of the best you'll have while on retreat! Coffee, tea, juice and water and cookies & fruit are available at any time in the dining room.

**Supplies:** Bed & bath linens and bar soap are provided. Please bring your personal items such as shampoo, shaving cream, razors, toothpaste and slippers; a housecoat is recommended as the bathrooms are shared. We don't provide hair dryers or alarm clocks. Our laundry facilities: washers, dryers, detergent, an iron and ironing board for your use.

During your time here you will build community with those in the same program and much of this is around meals which are generally provided for you. When the kitchen is closed your group's meals will be arranged through the Kitchen Manager. This may include self-serve continental breakfast, the heating of meals made by the kitchen staff, preparing some meals and eating out at the retreat house's expense.

**Communication:** Electronic correspondence and cell phone use are not permitted in any of the common areas.

**Local Weather:** In the winter, Guelph has snow and cold temperatures: warmer clothing and boots are needed. In the spring and fall, temperatures vary. In the summer months it can be very hot.
